

Tribal Public Health Infrastructure: Round Two Sub-awards

Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. If my organization received funding from Round One of the Tribal Public Health Infrastructure Subawards, are we still eligible to apply for this second round?**

No

- 2. What is the anticipated number of awards for this program?**

We anticipate being able to fund a minimum of 2 awards and potentially up to a maximum of 4-5 awards. The final number of awards will depend on the number of applications received, the amount of funds requested, and how competitive the applications are.

- 3. How many documents should I have in my completed application and what are they?**

Complete applications should include the following five documents:

- 1) Application form signed by an authorized representative
- 2) Workplan including goals, objectives, activities, timelines and evaluation
- 3) Budget (using provided template)
- 4) Budget narrative (using provided template)
- 5) Contact information form (using provided template).

- 4. If I submit an application and it is missing one of the 5 required documents, will I have the opportunity to re-submit missing documentation?**

No, applications that are not complete and submitted by May 28, 2025, will not be considered.

- 5. Can you tell me if my specific project is eligible for funding under this award opportunity?**

We cannot address specific questions about the eligibility of projects/proposals for this award.

- 6. Where can I find the descriptions of the Foundational Public Health Services?**

- 7. Can you have more than one application from a singular organization?**

Yes, an organization can submit more than one application. Please keep in mind that applications must be signed by an authorized representative. Even if an entity submits multiple applications, only one will be funded per entity, so please be sure to coordinate internally.

8. What is the funding source for this opportunity?

This sub-award opportunity is funded by federal funds. Additional information about the funding source can be found in the application document.

9. Does my application need to respond to all of the categories mentioned in the Foundational Public Health Services Framework? Is there a minimum number of areas or capabilities that need to be included in my project/proposal?

Proposals are not required to address more than one foundational area or capability to be considered for this opportunity.

10. Are vehicles an allowable purchase under this funding opportunity?

No, the purchase of any type of vehicle is not allowable for this sub-award opportunity.

11. Are there any specific project narrative directions?

No, there are no specific directions. On the slides from the TA call, we do recommend including an impact statement, but this is not required. As long as everything is included that is listed on the application (timeline, goals, objectives, etc), that will be considered sufficient.

12. Can I include a request to fund medical equipment or clinical care in my application?

Medical equipment and clinical care are not acceptable projects for this funding opportunity.
