
Definition

Adult overweight/obesity is measured for persons aged 18 years and older having a body mass index of 25.0 kg/m² or more. Overweight/obesity is an important risk factor for chronic diseases and other health problems such as heart disease, cancers, high blood pressure, type 2 diabetes, stroke, and respiratory problems.

Summary

- During 2019-2023, 67.3% of Alaska Native adults reported having overweight/obesity according to their BMI. This was lower than non-Alaska Native adults (67.8%), although the difference is not statistically significant.
- The percent of overweight/obese Alaska Native and non-Alaska Native adults has increased between 2019 and 2023, although the difference is not statistically significant.
- During 2019-2023, the percent of Alaska Native adults with overweight/obesity varied by Tribal health region, ranging from 53.5% to 75.9%.

Alaska Non-Native People


