
Intentional Injury Deaths


During 2014-2023:

- There were 986 intentional injury deaths among Alaska Native people (68 per 100,000) and 1,599 among non-Alaska Native people (27 per 100,000)
- There were 715 intentional injury deaths among Alaska Native males (98 per 100,000) and 271 among Alaska Native females (38 per 100,000)
- Alaska Native people aged 20-29 years had the highest intentional injury death rate among any age group (154 per 100,000)
- There were 718 Suicide deaths and 268 Homicide deaths among Alaska Native people




